- Qualifying exam for the National Merit Scholarship
- Students in grade 10 and interested students in grade 9 and 11 will take the PSAT on October 11, 2017.
- Free for any 10th grade student
- Students in grades 9 and 11 may self-pay
- Grade 11 students who are eligible for free/reduced lunch may receive fee waivers
- Students can create a College Board account and link their scores to the Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy to develop a free and individualized practice plan to improve scores on future examinations of the PSAT & SAT.

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Graduation Requirements for Florida's Statewide Assessments

- The requirements students must meet in order to graduate with a standard high school diploma are determined by their year of enrollment in grade 9.
- Among them are required assessments; students can retake the Grade 10 FSA ELA and the Algebra 1 EOC Assessment until achieving a passing score.
- A student can also graduate by receiving a score concordant to the FSA ELA passing score on either the ACT or SAT and a score comparative to the Algebra 1 EOC Assessment passing score on the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT).
