**Students entering the school from a Spanish Speaking Country will be tested/recommended by a Spanish teacher in the department to ensure a correct placement regardless the grade.

- (1) AP Spanish Language: Students placed in this course should be in the 11th grade AND have been completed Spanish II. Any other case MUST be tested and recommended by the department.
- (2) AP Spanish Literature: Students placed in this course should be in the 12th grade AND have completed/passed AP Spanish Language. Any other case MUST be tested and recommended by the department.

Spanish/Portuguese/French Cambridge courses (AS and A Level) are open to all students who receive teacher's recommendation
