**Equivalent to GCE A/AS Level Examinations*

- Course selection is based on Teacher, Counselor, and Student recommendation. There is no limit on the number of Honors, AP and/or AICE courses a student may take.
- Students participating in Band, Orchestra, Journalism, Dance and Chorus are required to enroll in a program course during the day for each year of participation.
- Student may accelerate through Dual Enrollment and Florida Virtual School. A variety of advanced placement classes are available through these programs.
- Students are not permitted to change course curriculum after transcripts are sent to the universities.

Special Recognition

Miami Dade School System does not rank students. Special recognition is given after seven semesters:

- **Summa Cum Laude:** Top 5% of the class
- **Magna Cum Laude:** Next 5% of the class
- **Cum Laude:** Upper 15% of class or students who have a 4.0 GPA or higher, excluding previous categories

- After the 6th semester of the 2014 school year:

- Highest weighted GPA is 6.417
- Median GPA is a 3.506
