All interscholastic athletics and school activities are meant to contribute to the overall academic excellence achieved by a student participant.

Activities INCLUDE being able to park in the student parking lot.

The following rules and consequences are seen as the basic conditions that must be met by a student:

- 1.) A student must maintain a cumulative 2.00 GPA or higher as specified by s. 1003.43(1) Florida Statutes.
- 2.) A student must receive a minimum 2.00 in conduct each semester.
- 3.) If a student is assigned to School Center for Specialized Instruction (SCSI), he or she will be unable to participate in interscholastic competition or performance on the day(s) on which he or she is assigned. If the assignment to SCSI takes place on/or includes a Friday, the student will be unable to participate in interscholastic competition or performance on Saturday.
- 4.) A student who is serving an external suspension cannot practice or participate in interscholastic competition or performance and may be subject to further sanctions or penalties.
- 5.) A student who has a total of eleven (11) days suspension will not be allowed to participate in interscholastic competition or performance for the remainder of the school year.
- 6.) A student who has ten (10) or more absences will not be allowed to participate in interscholastic competition or performance for the remainder of the school year.
- 7.) A student who has 20 or more tardies will not be allowed to participate in interscholastic competition or performance for the remainder of the school year.
- 8.) A student must be reported as present for the school day in order to participate in interscholastic competition or performance.
- 9.) A student who participates in interscholastic competition or performance and has not performed at grade level as defined by Florida Department of Education will attend two (2) hours per week of academic tutoring. Failure to attend required tutoring will result in a seven (7) calendar day suspension from interscholastic competition or performance.
- 10.) Any student who is arrested for conduct occurring on or off school grounds will be prohibited from participating in all interscholastic competition or performance for a minimum of ten (10) days.
